3. The City of Gastonia reserves the right to re-open the streets at any time.
4. We have made arrangements for the clean-up of litter deposited along the streets due to the activity approved by this permit.
5. Liability insurance may be required as determined by the Human Resources Department.
- *6. We are responsible for securing approval from the North Carolina Department of Transportation if event requires the closing of a state-maintained street.

A sketch-map indicating the following information is required to be attached to this permit.

- (a) The area where the event is to take place.
- (b) Any streets to be closed or obstructed.
- (c) Any barriers or traffic control devices that will be erected.
- (d) The location of any concession stand, booth or other temporary structure or facilities.

(e) The location of proposed fences, stands, platforms, benches, or bleachers.

NOTE TO APPLICANT: During the term of this permit, if said event violates any General Statute of the State of North Carolina, then this permit shall be null and void.
Permit must be returned to the Engineering Department no later than 10 business days prior to the event.
