SUBJECT: **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MYRTLE SCHOOL ROAD**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has scheduled the replacement of a failed storm drainage cross pipe on Myrtle School Road between Amber Crest Drive and Myrtlewoods Drive. Work will begin Tuesday, March 9, 2010, and continue through Thursday, March 11, 2010. Crews will saw cut the roadway on Tuesday, while maintaining one lane of traffic. The roadway will be closed to through traffic Wednesday and Thursday.

The detour for southbound traffic will be Franklin Boulevard, Garrison Boulevard, Chester Street, York Road, and Hudson Boulevard. Northbound traffic will be detoured onto Linwood Road, Garrison Boulevard, and Franklin Boulevard. The construction will, also, be posted on the Traffic Information Management System (TIMS) on the NCDOT website. Access to adjacent properties will be available.
