SUBJECT: 2014 Energy Efficiency Rebates Update

The purpose of this memorandum is to update you on the status of the NCMPA1 Energy Efficiency Rebates.

After discussing the rebate program with the NCMPA1 Rate Committee in March, it was decided that the Energy Efficiency rebates will remain per the chart below until further notice. Heat Pump (14.0-14.9 SEER)	\$400
Heat Pump (15.0-15.9 SEER)	\$400
Heat Pump (16 SEER or higher)	\$400
Electric Water Heaters	\$150
Energy Star Homes*	\$500
Commercial Solar Thermal	\$450/certified panel
Commercial Energy Efficient Lighting **	\$0.35/watt saved
Commercial RFP program ***	No longer available

*Energy Star Home rebates must meet HERS standards for Energy Star Homes. Rebates are not dependent upon water conservation measures prescribed in the standards. For more information contact Phil Bisesi at 919-760-6295.

**Lighting rebates are available to C&I customers for qualifying lighting projects. The amount of the rebate is 35 cents per watt saved, up to a maximum of \$25,000 or half of the total project cost, whichever is less.
