

### **City offers Rx discount card**

City residents who do not have health insurance, a traditional benefits plan or have prescriptions that are not covered by insurance can now take advantage of a prescription discount program that can save them an average of 20% off the retail cost of prescription medications.

The program, which provides a free prescription discount card, is made available to Gastonia residents by the City in conjunction with the National League of Cities and CVS Caremark. The card can be used at participating pharmacies and can save cardholders an average of 20% off the retail cost of prescription drugs not already covered by insurance or some other benefits plan.
