



Proclamation

WHEREAS, In 1872 J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for the planting of trees, which is now called **Arbor Day** and was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, 2019 is the **147th anniversary** of **Arbor Day** which is now observed throughout the nation and world; and

WHEREAS, trees can reduce the erosion of our topsoil, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate temperatures, clean the air, produce life-giving oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, not only are trees a renewable resource, they also increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas and beautify our community; and

WHEREAS, March 22nd is Arbor Day in North Carolina, and Keep Gastonia Beautiful will observe Arbor Day at Martha Rivers Park on Friday, March 22, as Gastonia has been named Tree City USA for our 18th year, and on that day shall receive this award, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Walker E. Reid III, Mayor, and the City Council of the City of Gastonia do hereby proclaim **March 22, 2019** as

ARBOR DAY

and support **Keep Gastonia Beautiful Arbor Day Celebration's** and urge all citizens to celebrate **Arbor Day** by supporting the efforts to protect our trees and woodlands, and

FURTHER, encourage all citizens to plant trees in Gastonia for our future generations.
