Help Locate Additional Suspects Charged in Quik Trip Incident

GASTONIA, N.C. – Feb. 7, 2020 – Gastonia Police are asking for the public's help to locate suspects involved in larcenies and inciting a riot during the incident at the Quik Trip, 1843 W. Franklin Blvd., early Sunday morning that left a store employee with serious injuries to her face.

- 2) Rebecca Alisha Dawkins of Kings Mountain is charged with felony inciting a riot and misdemeanor larceny.
- 3) De'Mallon Lamarea White of Kings Mountain is charged with felony inciting a riot.
- 4) Laquisha Breun Burris of Gastonia is charged with misdemeanor larceny.
- 5) Derrick Anthony Davis of Grover is charged with felony inciting a riot.
